

RULES FOR EXEMPTION FROM THE REGISTRATION FEE OF UNDERGRADUATES

01. The Organizing Committee of the Conference will grant partial exemption from payment of the registration fee for 10 authors |as or co-authors |as who had the Abstract approved at the VII Coimbra International Conference on Human Rights and who are enrolled in an undergraduate course of an Institution of Higher Education. The exemption corresponds to 50% (fifty percent) of the fee for students.

02. The registrations for the attribution of the exemption of the registration fee will be carried out, exclusively, by filling out an electronic form available on the official website of the Congress (www.cidhcoimbra.com), in which, necessarily, the information and documents requested below must be inserted:

I – Full name;

II – Student affiliation institution;

III - Proof of enrollment in an undergraduate course issued by the educational institution in the year 2022.

03. Applications to receive the exemption from the registration fee must be made from July 25th to July 31st, 2022.

04. To select the authors and co-authors, the Organizing Committee will evaluate the respective Abstracts approved in the Thematic Symposia of the Congress, according to the following criteria: Relevance of the Theme; Identification of the Research Problem; Study Objectives; Methodology; Relevance of Expected/Achieved Results.

05. The publication of the list of authors and co-authors exempt from the registration fee for the Congress will be presented on the official page of the event (www.cidhcoimbra.com), until August 5, 2022.

06. Authors not covered by the exemption from the registration fee may also register for the Congress by paying the full amount of the fee, in accordance with the rules set out in the 2022 Abstracts Call Notice.
